3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Responsible Wildland
- 5 Fire Recovery Act".

6 SEC. 2. PURPOSE.

7 The purpose of this Act is to ensure that victims of
8 wildland fires resulting from management activities con9 ducted by the Department of Agriculture on National For10 est System land are eligible to receive 100 percent funding

for the cost of remediating direct and indirect damages
 under authorized Federal recovery programs.

3 SEC. 3. COST-SHARE WAIVER FOR REHABILITATION FROM 4 WILDLAND FIRES.

5 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) COVERED MATCHING REQUIREMENT.—The 7 term "covered matching requirement" means a re-8 quirement under a program of the Secretary for 9 wildland fire recovery for a State, Indian Tribe, lo-10 cality, or individual to provide matching funds, in 11 cash, for a project.

(2) COVERED WILDLAND FIRE.—The term
"covered wildland fire" means a wildland fire that
the Secretary determines to be a result of management activities conducted by the Secretary on National Forest System land.

17 (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means18 the Secretary of Agriculture.

19 (4) WILDLAND FIRE.—

20 (A) IN GENERAL.—The term "wildland
21 fire" means any non-structure fire that occurs
22 in vegetation or natural fuels.

23 (B) INCLUSIONS.—The term "wildland
24 fire" includes wildfire, prescribed fire, and any

direct or indirect damage resulting in watershed
 impairment.

3 (b) WAIVER.—Notwithstanding any other provision 4 of law, the Secretary may waive any covered matching re-5 quirement for a project in response to a covered wildland 6 fire that is in an area affected by that covered wildland 7 fire.
