- 7 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 8 sion of law, the final rule of the Pipeline and Hazardous

- 2 60102(q) of title 49, United States Code, on January 17,
- 3 2025, relating to "Pipeline Safety: Gas Pipeline Leak De-

- 7 (b) Subsequent Updates.—Nothing in this section
